The Brief

A staff recognition programme was set up for all members of staff and for Quarter 1, the client wanted to have a high end venue where the winners could participate in various country activities.

Our Response

This venue is set in a 250 acre estate featuring 3 trout lakes surrounded by woodland. The hospitality area and conference suite are housed in a magnificent 18th century barn which has been sympathetically converted to offer the best of both worlds i.e. log fires combine with the sophistication of modern conference facilities.



There are many activities to choose from such as clay shooting, archery, air pistol shooting, rage

buggies, 4x4 driving, tractor driving, falconry, hovercraft driving to teambuilding exercises, the ropes course and raft building.

Itinerary

The quests arrived and were welcomed with tea, coffee and home-made biscuits.

The group were briefed on the day's activities and then split into groups to rotate around the activities which included:

Archery

Set within the large estate surrounded by woodland with life-size as well as moving targets being used, guests used traditional bows and arrows.



Clay Shooting

The original country pursuit, and always enjoyed. Special lightweight guns are provided if required. The experienced instructors can turn any novice into a crack shot!

Lunch

Guests returned to the barn for a fabulous home-made finger buffet and then took part in the activities they did not complete in the morning.





Hovercraft Driving

The hovercraft provided an unusual test of co-ordination skills and an element of competition. Each hovercraft is managed by an experienced instructor who ensures the programme runs smoothly and the clients get the most out of the machines. These safe air cushion machines are easy to drive and promise an exciting and rewarding day out for everyone.



Rage Buggies

These are large grass go-carts at the heart of which is a robust Honda V-Twin petrol engine, giving a strong performance from its 620cc capacity. Guests do timed laps around the obstacle course and the team with the best time wins!



End of the day

Guests return to the barn for tea, home-made cakes followed by prize giving for the best at each activity.
